### **GUIDELINES FOR THE YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP**

#### **Requirements for Receiving a Scholarship**

- A. Completed applications must be submitted on the proper form obtained from the Scholarship Fund Committee Chairperson no later than August 1<sup>st</sup> of the year that scholarship is to be awarded.
- B. The applicant must be a member of the ARBA and the APRC for at least three years prior to submitting an application.
- C. Applicants must be under the age of 20, a graduating high school senior or in their first year of a two or four year college, university, community college or vocational school.
- D. Applicants must submit an official high school transcript showing a GPA of 2.70 or higher on a scale of 4.0
- E. One scholarship shall be awarded each year. Recipient will be announced at the APRC banquet held at the ARBA Convention.
- F. Scholarship award will be sent to the college chosen by the recipient upon proof of enrollment.
- G. The Scholarship Committee shall make the final decision.
- H. If there is no qualifying applicant; funds will remain in the APRC Youth Scholarship Fund.
